The new Carer's Leave Act 2024 will come into effect this April.

If you care (unpaid) for a loved one or friend and work, you will be entitled to a statutory flexible one week of unpaid leave per year. This can be taken as either half or full days. The new entitlement will be available to all employees regardless of how long they have been working for a company.

Carers Roadshow 2024

As part of Carers Week 2024, Barnsley Healthcare Federation are hosting their second carers roadshow at the Priory Centre Lundwood, and we will be in attendance.

A staggering 82% of carers surveyed by Carers UK said the impact of caring on their physical and mental health would be a challenge over the coming year, with nearly 60% adding that being valued as a carer would improve their wellbeing.

The theme for Carers Week 2024 is 'Putting carers on the map' and the roadshow is a chance for those who provide care to loved ones to speak to health, care and voluntary services who can support them.


